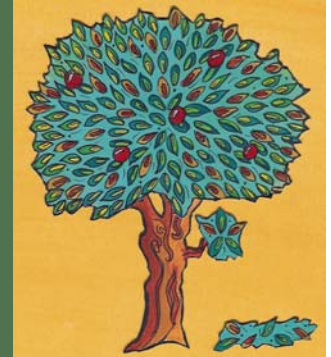




- Do you dare to think big?
